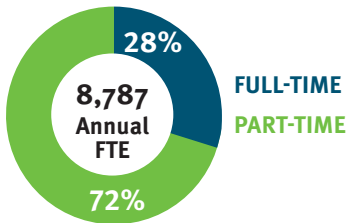

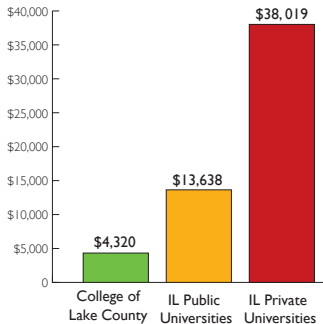
Total annual number of students

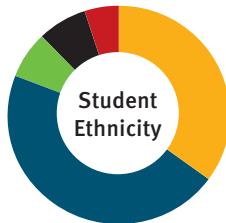

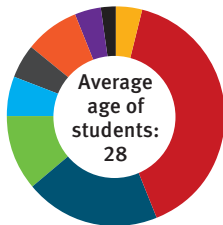

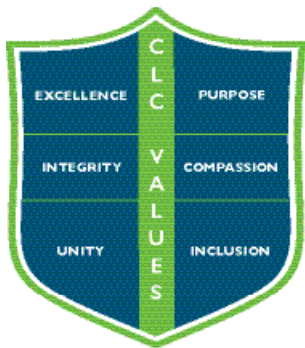
